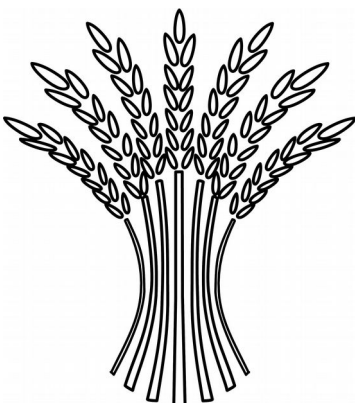


God in three persons
